DRESS CODE 2011-2012

GRADES Nursery - Grade 8

The dress code is a general guide that is not all inclusive. The dress code requires clothing that is practical for active children in an elementary school setting. Dressing for school is not the same as dressing for leisure time outside of school. Standards of cleanliness, neatness, and appropriateness in dress are expected for the classroom and school day.

It is the responsibility of the parents to see that their children come to school dressed according to the dress code. Please adhere to the "spirit" as well as the letter of the guidelines.

Specific guidelines for appropriate dress are:

General:

- All clothes should be neat, clean, modest.
- Hair styles, make-up, jewelry should be modest and not cause a distraction.
- Plain belts are optional.

Not Acceptable

- No frayed, ripped or patched clothing.
- No jean shorts, leggings, spandex.
- No visible body piercing (other than pierced ears for girls only).
- No athletic/sports wear, hooded clothing, work clothes or military clothing.
- No clogs or any open back shoes (for safety reasons).
- Long-sleeve shirts may not be worn under short sleeve shirts.
- No layered shirts (shirt tails hanging out from another shirt).

Boys:

- **All school clothes must be purchased through the school uniform lines.**
 - Oxford or collared "polo" shirts or turtlenecks. Oxford shirts worn tucked in. Polo shirts of appropriate length may or may not be tucked in. **All shirts must be in solid colors or stripes.**
 - Solid-color sweaters or **Pen Ryn sweatshirts worn over the shirts/turtlenecks.**
 - Chinos, cargo pants, shorts, or other style pants in tan (khaki), black, or navy blue.
 - Sneakers or shoes and socks
 - Solid-color fleece ordered through Kampus Klothes or **Lands End must have the Pen Ryn Logo** and may be worn during class.

Girls:

- **All school clothes must be purchased through the school uniform lines.**
 - Oxford or collared "polo" shirts with sleeves or turtlenecks that are not too tight. Oxford shirts worn tucked in. Polo shirts of appropriate length may or may not be tucked in. All shirts must be in solid colors or stripes.
 - Solid-color sweaters or Pen Ryn sweatshirts worn over the shirts/turtlenecks.
 - Solid-color fleece ordered through Kampus Klothes or Lands End must have the Pen Ryn Logo and may be worn during class.
 - Chino-style pants, capris, skirts, shorts, skorts, cargo pants, and jumpers in tan (khaki), black, or navy blue. Skirts should be an appropriate length for school.
 - Sneakers or shoes with socks, solid-color knee socks, or tights.

Phys. Ed. Uniform

Grades 4-8 Students change and need to bring:

- Any Pen Ryn T-shirt
- Navy-blue, royal-blue, black or gray mesh gym shorts or navy blue sweat pants
- No jewelry

Nursery-3

Wear dress code clothing appropriate for active participation such as pants and a polo shirt. Students go to gym and wear whatever they wear to school. Sneakers are the most appropriate.

Enforcement:

The classroom teachers will monitor student dress each day.

Nursery through 3rd Grade - Parents will be notified if a student is dressed inappropriately. If the problem persists a parent conference will be held and the parent may be asked to bring a change of clothes to school.

Grades 4 -8 - A student who is inappropriately dressed will be required to change clothes in order to attend class and parents will be notified (a supply of Pen Ryn wear will be on hand for these occasions). Repeat offenses will be dealt with on an individual basis with the understanding that the student will not attend class until properly dressed. Further consequences may be applied according to the school's disciplinary guidelines.

The administration is the final arbiter in interpreting the dress code.
