DRESS CODE 2019-2020

The dress code requires clothing that is practical for active children in an elementary school setting. Dressing for school is not the same as dressing for leisure time outside of school. Standards of cleanliness, neatness, and appropriateness in dress are expected for the classroom and school day. It is the responsibility of the parents to see that their children come to school dressed according to the dress code. Please adhere to the "spirit" as well as the letter of the guidelines.

- Field trip/spirit shirts are required for students and can be purchased through school.
- Pen Ryn sweatshirts are the only sweatshirts allowed during class time.
- Hair styles, make-up, jewelry should be modest and not cause a distraction.
- Hats may not be worn in the school building.

PreK3-Kindergarten(Girls/Boys):

Tops	Bottoms
Collared shirts	Solid cargo pants, sweatpants and shorts
Sweaters	Skirts and dresses
Spirit shirts	Comfort and independence is the priority
Pen Ryn sweatshirt (only sweatshirt allowed)	Bottoms that a child can manage with no assistance
	Sneakers are the only appropriate shoes

Grades 1st-8th

Tops	Bottoms	Shoes
Oxford or collared shirts (solid or stripes)	Cargo pants, shorts, or other style pants in tan (khaki), black, grey or navy blue	Sneakers
Sweaters	Capri's, skirts, shorts, skorts, and jumpers in tan (khaki), black, grey or navy blue.	No open toed, backless shoes or sandals
Spirit shirts (for field trips and gym day)	Skirts and shorts should be an appropriate length for school.	Boots and shoes must be weather appropriate (no heeled boots)
Pen Ryn sweatshirt (only sweatshirt allowed)		Sneakers to change into during inclement weather is recommended

Not Acceptable

No frayed, ripped or patched clothing
No visible body piercing
No hooded clothing, work clothes or military clothing
No logo and graphics on clothing

Phys. Ed. Uniform: Students in grades 4-8 should wear the following on gym day:

Tops	Bottoms
Blue or gold spirit shirt	Navy blue or black athletic pants
Pen Ryn athletic shirt	Navy blue or black shorts of appropriate length
Pen Ryn sweatshirt (only sweatshirt allowed)	Sneakers

PreK3-3

Students may wear the same as the above Phys. Ed Uniform - but it is not required. Students will go to gym and wear whatever they wore to school. Sneakers are the most appropriate.

Dress Down Day Guidelines:

Tops	Bottoms
All tops must have sleeves and back	Jeans
Midriff or undergarments should not be visible	Leggings
School appropriate logos or designs	Skirts & dresses
	Athletic pants or shorts of appropriate length

Enforcement:

The classroom teachers will monitor student dress each day.

Pre-K3 through 4th Grade - Parents will be notified if a student is dressed inappropriately. If the problem persists a parent conference will be held and the parent may be asked to bring a change of clothes to school.

Grades 5 -8 - A student who is inappropriately dressed will be required to change clothes in order to attend class and parents will be notified (a supply of Pen Ryn wear will be on hand for these occasions). Repeat offenses will be handled on an individual basis with the understanding that the student will not attend class until properly dressed. Further consequences may be applied according to the school's disciplinary guidelines.

The administration is the final arbiter in interpreting the dress code.
