



Supply List for Pre-K 3

2020 - 2021



When you shop for school items, please follow these guidelines:

School clothes:

- **All** PK3 children may purchase dress code approved attire (collared polo shirts, chino/cargo style pants, shorts, skorts and jumpers). ELASTIC WAISTBAND PREFERRED!
Knit pants, sweat pants, knit shorts and sweat shorts with elastic waistbands are PREFERRED and permitted in grades **PK3 and Pre-K only.
- Sneakers are the most appropriate shoes for **All** PK3 children.

School supplies:

- **All** PK3 children need a **large** backpack. Please choose one that is at least 18" X 13" (NO wheelies please, as they will not fit in their cubbies and NO messenger bags please, as they are difficult for the children to handle.) The backpack needs to be able to hold papers as well as a lunch box/bag (full day students), and sometimes bulky items (such as coats, hats and projects).
- **All** PK3 children need: a package of Huggies wipes, a container of Clorox Disinfectant wipes and a container of hand sanitizer (at least 8 oz.) to be kept in the classroom. These 3 supplies may need to be replenished throughout the school year.
- **Full** Day PK3 children should have a lunchbox. Please choose one that will fit **inside** their backpack.
- **Full** Day PK3 children need a **small** blanket for rest time. Please choose one that is approx. 3' X 5' (NO sleeping bags, please). The blanket will be kept at school in their cubby. **Small** Pillow Pet pillows may also be kept at school for rest time.
- **Full** Day PK3 children may bring a small "beanie baby size" stuffed animal for rest time. Please choose a "new" school friend, as it will not be coming home each night. It will remain at school in their cubby.

Necessary classroom items:

- **All** PK3 children need to bring a change of clothes to be **kept in the classroom** – for emergency changes. Please put underwear, socks, dress code pants and shirt (according to season) in a large Ziploc bag labeled with the child's name.
- **All** PK3 children need to bring a family photo to school (no larger than 5X7). It will be displayed in our classroom on the Family bulletin board for the entire school year.
