Nicely ask a grown up for a snack you can count such as blueberries or goldfish crackers. Can you split your snack into equal groups? This is called division!

Go on a scavenger hunt in your neighborhood. Take pictures of every shape you see! Try to find 3D shapes too!

Write your addition math facts with sidewalk chalk. You can pick any facts from 1-12. Take a picture of your work when it is complete.
