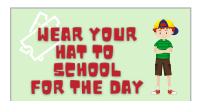
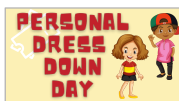

Make sure you show your parents and get their signature on each activity you complete.

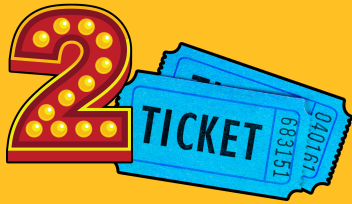

# 2ND GRADE ACTIVITIES



For Resources



Skip count by 2s, 5s, and 10s to 100 aloud to a grown up.

Ask a grown up for a snack you can count. Organize your snack into groups of ten. How many pieces do you have in all? Show your grown up.

Design an analog clock and create a daily schedule for a day in the summer. (Scan QR Code for clock)

Use *The Snake's Diary* book, or get a picture book, tell the story to a grown up, just by using the pictures.

Read a story and retell to a grown up using story map features (character, setting, problem, solution). (Scan QR Code for story map)

Read a piece of literature from around the world (folktale, fairy tale, or myth) and write a letter to a character.. (Scan QR Code for example)

Interview any two grown ups in your family about what they do as a career and how they got there. (Scan QR Code for questions)

Grab a piece of chalk to head outside and practice addition facts up to 20 for 5 minutes. (Scan QR Code for facts)

Make your own flashcards for addition and subtraction facts to 20. (Scan QR Code for facts)

Find two of your favorite toys and write two word problems about them. Don't forget to solve.

Grab a piece of chalk to head outside and practice subtraction facts from 20 for 5 minutes. (Scan QR Code for facts)

Create a family tree, going as far back as you can, about where your family came from. OR Create a timeline of your life so far including big accomplishments.

Find your favorite spot outside and read *Sea Life* or any other non-fiction book.

Write a story about something that happened to you one day in the summer. Draw a picture to go with it.
